## **COMMUNICATE!** Realize people do care about what you think.

- •Use social media to advance the world we want post on Facebook, twitter, emails, insta gram
- •Send appreciative emails to columnists who are supporting democracy. Send them in formation about resources they might use.
- •Write Letters to editor. D&C is limited, but City and Messenger Post will probably publish them. Feel free to draw from any of the materials in this document
- •Call in to talk shows giving the kind of information in this document. Keep a positive tone.
- •Host gatherings where you show videos about the threats to democracy and discuss. e.g. https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=Yu3HikdxJn0 Cartoon on Authoritarianism.
- •Write your own blog e.g. see A White Guy In Rochester (Frank Staropoli)

- Listen openly to those with whom you may not agree. Speak your truth with courage and humility.
- •Initiate conversations with friends and family e.g. about democracy, about tyranny, about separation of church and state. Ask them what they are concerned about.

## **GET ACTIVE POLITICALLY**

- Run for office!
- Build a relationship with your Congressman (Joe Morelle for most of us).
  - o Send him your opinions frequently. Ask him to respond.
  - o Join a group that visits him regularly to express your concerns
  - o Let him know you'll have his back on important issues
  - o Check out Issue Voter for suggestions about actions
- Remember local and state governments can make strong statements and positions.
- Join Americans United (AU.org) to keep up to date on Church-State Issues
